things before we go.

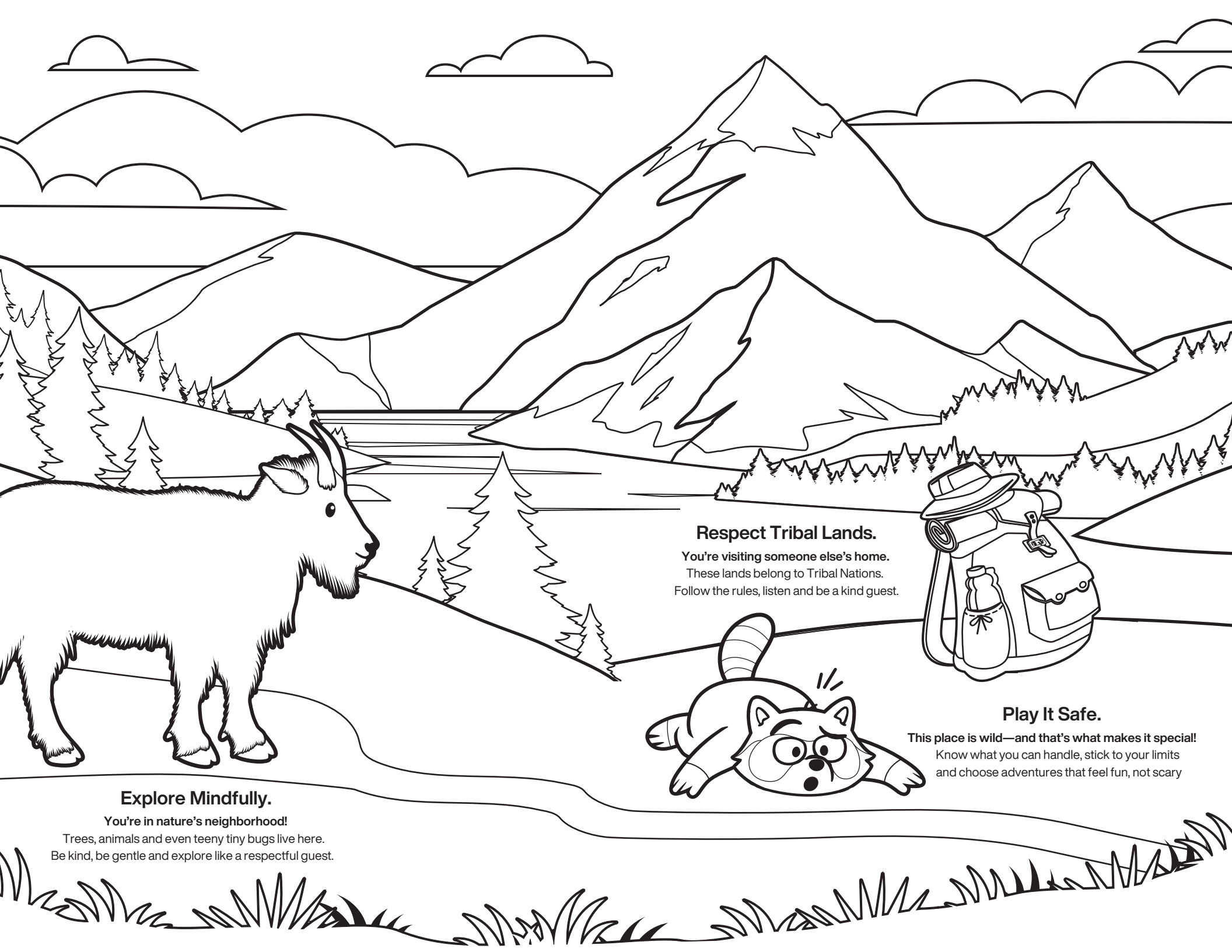


**Know Before You Go.**

Follow the rules, listen and be a kind guest.



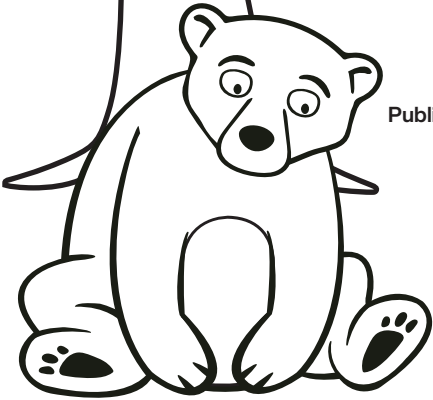
### Play It Safe.

and choose adventures that feel fun, not scary



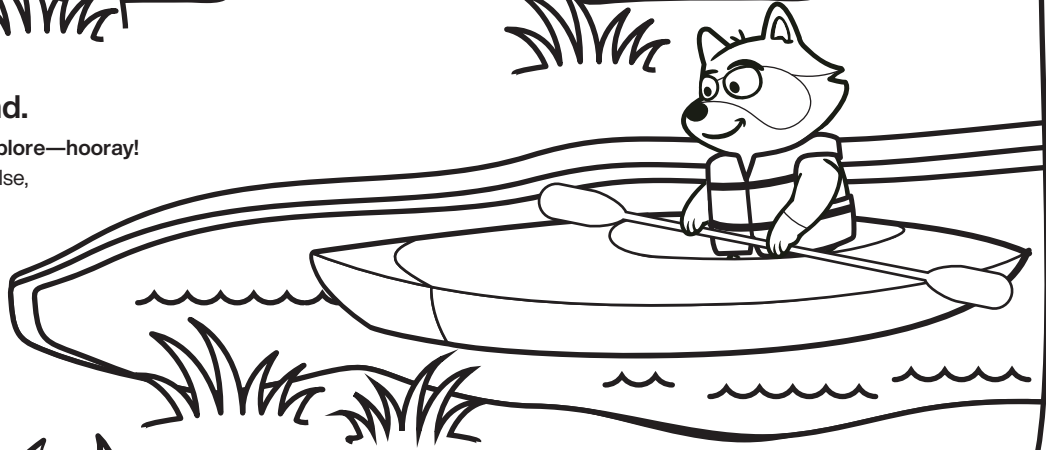
### Public vs Private Land.

who's carrying bear spray.

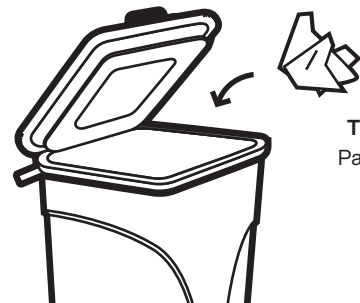
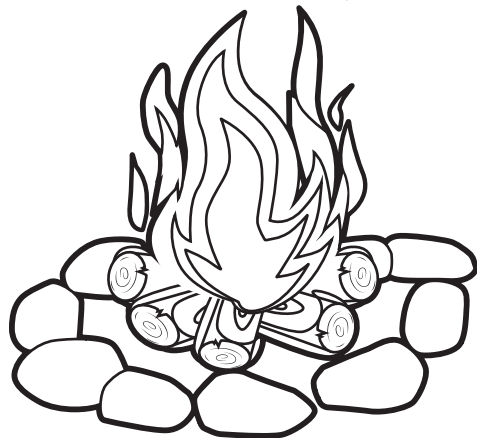


### Keep Our Waters Clean.
