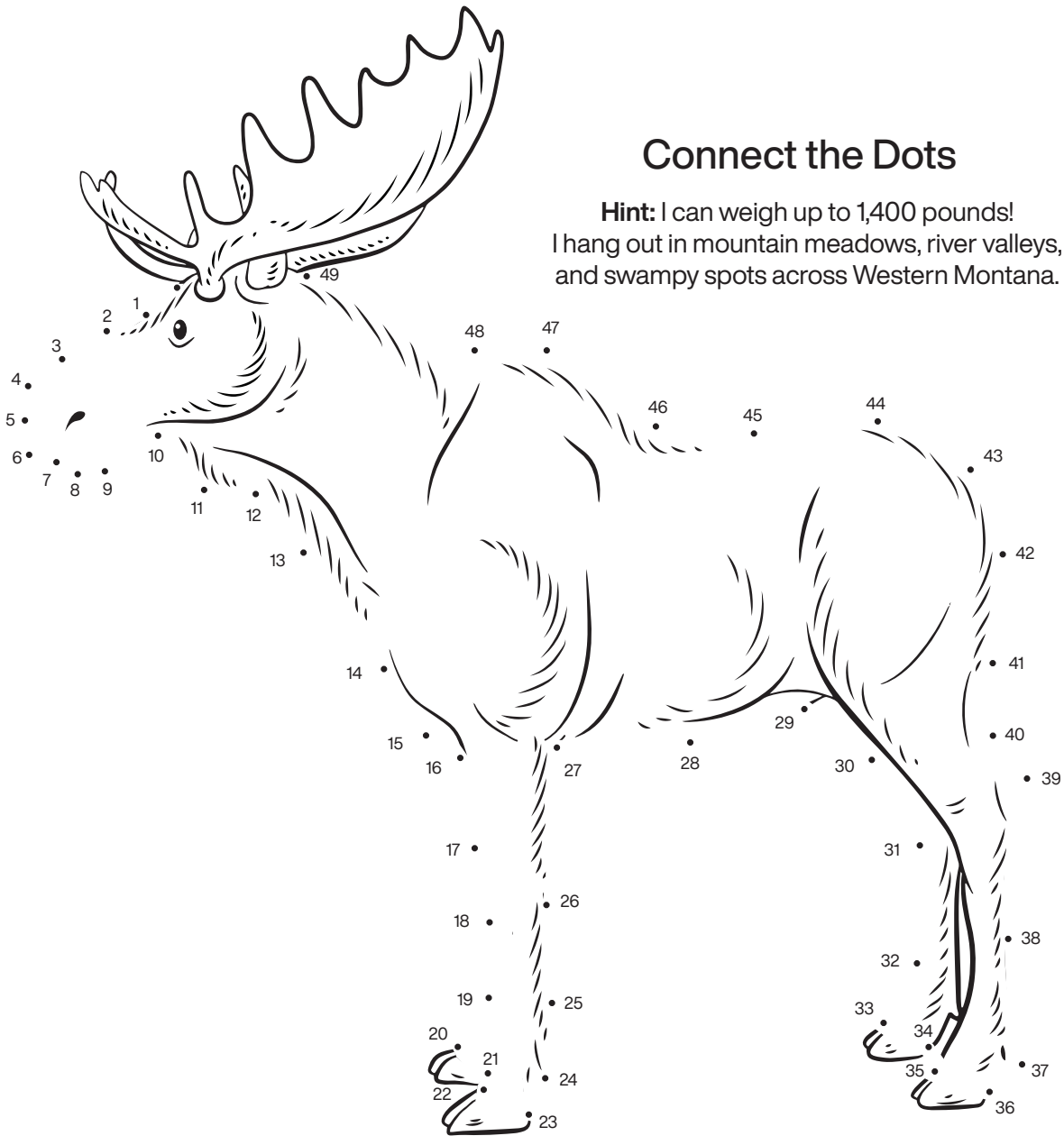

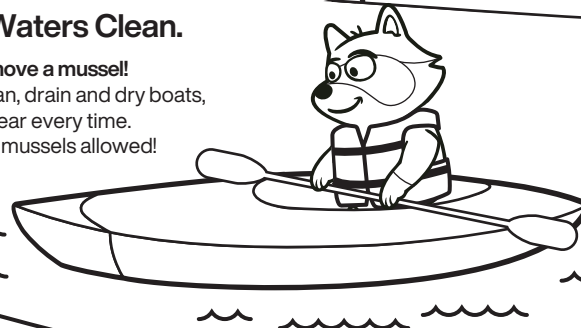


Explore Mindfully.

 No hitchhiking mussels allowed!

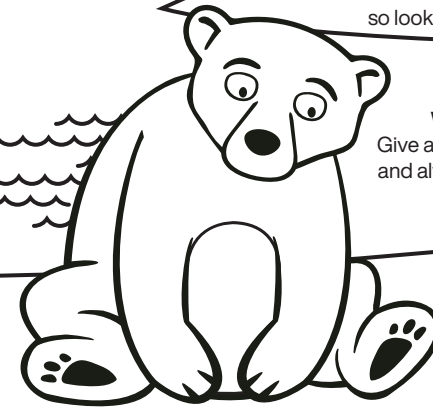


Public vs. Private Land.

 carrying bear spray.



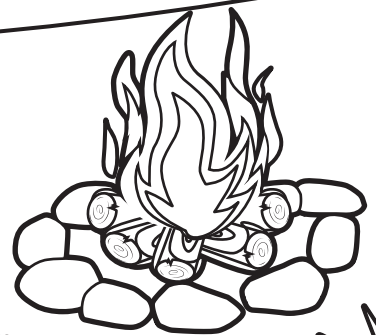
Play it Safe.
